Children are born right-brain dominant and completely authentic without any of the pressures that we all feel as we progress through life. Unfortunately, most children routinely lose their authenticity, often before they even start school. It begins when they have to make a choice about attachment. Do they cry because they are uncomfortable or do they not cry because it makes mommy uncomfortable? Generally they choose to stop crying and cling to the attachment that is necessary for survival. Likewise, when they start preschool and learn they have special gifts such as singing, running or banging on drums only to find that these gifts are too noisy or scary to be enjoyed by their parents. Then they have to choose again, and they generally decide to withhold their gifts because they make mommy uncomfortable and she needs peace and quiet.

These are just two examples of choices that young children make to maintain the attachment that is so necessary for their socialization in exchange for being their unique authentic selves. And while they are making these choices their right dominant brain is transitioning to left dominance. That's when they start elementary school and learn how to conform to the culture that the school offers. This is a left-brain dominant culture that includes dealing with bullies who are glad to give young children an identity, but it is usually not an authentic identity. Once in that routine, the ability to return to the right brain, learn self-awareness and be one's authentic self does not surface again, until a crises occurs and the student is forced to focus in new ways.

Educators have the ability to alter this reality and help their students understand themselves. After all, no where in the educational system do we teach children who they are. Isn't it time we take advantage of the audience we have with them to teach them about the person who lives within and how that person can most effectively thrive through life?

It's about teaching authenticity and Dr. Norma Hollis has become a master at it.

The Importance of Authenticity in Education

We have a dilemma in the education field, from early childhood to university level. That dilemma has to do with government requirements to meet left brain educational tasks while ignoring right brain development advancements. We are a society that has become imbalanced by left brain dominance and, given the rapidly changing landscape we are a part of, it is our right brain innovative skills that will keep us successful. This presentation gives a broad understanding of the role of the right brain as it relates to living with authenticity, the ability to be intuitive and ways to trust self even more. Many scholars believe that the future will belong to those who can use their natural gifts and talents to be innovative. That means they will be authentic!

Preparing Youth to be their Authentic Self in a Rapidly Changing World

Children come to the world fully authentic with natural gifts and talents that they are eager to share with the world. However, in the process of socializing into society, children often set their gifts aside to pursue paths influenced by others. In the future, the individual will likely be differentiated by how they develop their individuality, their natural gifts and talents, and authenticity. It is important to help children not only recognize their natural gifts and talents but also develop the type of thinking that strengthens them. And when their natural gifts and talents are developed as a vehicle to sustain themselves, they will be able to meet any challenge in life, no matter what happens in the world.
